

Orchestra Class Rules

1. Students are expected to be in the classroom when the tardy bell rings.
2. Students are expected to be in their seats, ready to tune, 2 minutes after the tardy bell.
3. Students may not leave the orchestra room without permission from the director.
4. Students are expected to exhibit mature, professional conduct at all times.
5. Students are expected to respect their own performance and that of others at all times.
6. Students are expected to have instrument, music, and sharpened pencil in every class. Pens are not allowed to be used on orchestra music.
7. Students are expected to perform at all times with proper sitting/standing posture and correct instrument and bow hold.
8. **NO** gum and/or food are allowed in class. Bottled water is the **ONLY** beverage allowed.
9. Students are expected to stay on task for the entire class period.
10. Students are expected to listen at all times and refrain from talking/extraneous noises.
11. Students are expected to refrain from using heavy perfumes, hairspray, cologne, etc. Absolutely **no spraying** of any kind is allowed in class.
12. Nail polish, mascara, lip gloss, or any type of makeup is not allowed in the orchestra room.
13. Sheet music and original orchestra music are not allowed to leave the classroom. NO EXCEPTIONS!
14. Students are expected to use the instrument storage room to store instruments and music.
15. All class rules apply to practice rooms and the instrument storage room.
16. Students are expected to clean up their own mess!
