

Performance Points 2011-2012

Students must earn 100 Performance Points each quarter. Points may not transfer from one quarter to the next. Points earned over the required 100 will be averaged as 100 in the quarter grade.

Students are responsible for submitting the Performance Points Form to the director each quarter by the due date. Late forms will be considered a 0 on the Performance Points grade.

Students earn Performance Points by performing above and beyond the required rehearsals/performances required by the curriculum. Each hour that the student spends in these extra-curricular activities is worth 10 points. Some examples of ways to earn Performance Points:

1. State Events
2. National Events
3. Community Contributions
4. Class Contributions
5. Private Lessons*

The following is a description of ways to earn Performance Points. ***Please note: the director reserves the right to add or subtract from the list as necessary. If in doubt, ask the director.***
