

Cello/Bass Instrument Rental Form

The School of the Arts is pleased to be able to offer quality cellos and basses for our students to rent during the school year. In order to maintain the quality of the instruments, each student is responsible for any damage that may occur to the instrument during the course of the school year. Please follow these simple guidelines to keep our instruments in top performance condition:

- Always store the instrument in its designation storage space. DO NOT leave the instrument in the room unattended.
- Always secure the instrument by pushing in the endpin when you are not playing.
- Always loosen the bow before putting it away.
- Always wipe the instrument clean with a soft cloth after each use.
- Always store the instrument out of high traffic areas when not in use (for example, behind the stage out of the path of people entering and exiting).
- Do not carve on or deface the instrument in any way.

Cello and bass players are responsible for buying their own rosin and rock stops/cello belts. The instrument rental fee will cover strings and mutes.
